General Dispensing Processing Requirements for Long Term Care and Home Infusion

Effective January 1, 2021

Effective January 1, 2021, Pharmacies shall submit the following values below in order to identify the Prescription Drug Service as a Non-Short Cycle Dispensed Long Term Care Facility or Home Infusion Therapy drug for Medicare Programs.
